**T**he Gospel of Christ is good for all seasons. While the COVID-19 pandemic has closed the doors of places of worship, it has not closed the door of the Church which was declared opened on the Day of Pentecost when over 3,000 souls received the Holy Ghost.

The text found in Romans 1:16, underscores the importance of the Gospel of Christ. **"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek."**

The setting of the text is quite interesting. The apostle, Paul, made three clear and definite statements as under:

1. I am debtor.
2. I am ready.
3. I am not ashamed.

Let us briefly examine each statement. How was Paul indebted to the Greeks, barbarians, wise and unwise? He was indebted to them in this sense. The Lord Jesus had entrusted him with His gospel which, alone, made salvation possible. So, Paul regarded himself as indebted to them until the time that he was able to preach to them the good news of Jesus' death, burial and resurrection.

Furthermore, Paul was eager to pay his debt. Therefore, he maintained a position of readiness to preach the gospel. Finally, Paul indicated that he was **"not ashamed of the gospel of Christ."** In other words, he was proud of the gospel.

Paul was **"not ashamed of the gospel"** for at least three reasons. Firstly, it is God's way. Secondly, the gospel works. Thirdly, the gospel works for **"every one that believeth."**

We would do well to follow Paul's example.

## GOOD STORIES

**The** COVID-19 pandemic continued to wreak havoc worldwide. Here in the USA, the number of cases has passed the one-million mark, and the number of deaths has passed the 58,000 mark. All of us, to varying degrees, have been negatively affected on many emotional fronts.

At the same time, however, many people have seized opportunities which they saw to minister to others. Their ministries have provided some good stories. Below, are some of them. And they all cover members of ANAT.

1. One of our brothers reached out to one of our ministers, checking on the status of two members. This resulted in the purchase and distribution of relevant food provisions.
2. By making appropriate checks, a couple found out that a family living close to them had been without an income for some time. The couple moved quickly to wire money to their account.
3. One of our ministers volunteered not only to deliver supplies to our seniors, but to call on some members periodically to collect their financial contributions and deliver them safely to the church.
4. One of our sisters formed a group of staff members who reached out to each other by providing short messages of hope and prayers for strength.
5. Another one of our sisters was a part of the managerial team which saw the need to help brighten the days of staff members. One way was to play upbeat songs of hope. Our sister recommended a song entitled, **"It's Going to be Alright - God is in Control."** Our sister was pleasantly surprised when the song she selected was accepted and played. Indeed, God is in control!
6. Arising out of New York's Mayor's decision to increase the number of healthcare workers, one of our nurses was called upon to play a leading role in the training process. This position has put her in contact with nurses from at least seven states. During these challenging times all these persons have had the opportunity to watch an Ambassador of Christ function.
