oday—in a very special way—we are celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

The relevant Biblical text is significant. "He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay." (Matthew 28:6)

These were the words that fell on the ears of Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James and Salome when they visited the sepulcher, armed with sweet spices to anoint the body of Jesus.

Why is the resurrection of Jesus significant and, therefore, worthy of celebration? Consider this. The resurrection provides that:

- Human beings can be saved or delivered from the power and the effects of sin. (Romans 1:16)
- Human beings can be kept saved. (1 Peter 1:4-5; 2 Timothy 1:12)

 Human beings can be raptured (caught away) at the return of Jesus for His church. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-17)

Salvation, as provided by Jesus, becomes actual when there is a positive response by individuals. Scripture makes it plain that the gospel of Christ is "the power of God to everyone that believeth." (Romans 1:16)

The positive responses by individuals thrive in a climate established by the "3 D's" model, that being desire, discipline and determination. Desire is the want to. Discipline is a sense of order and control to devise a plan for the realization of what is desired. Determination is the resolve, grit and fortitude to press on to the end.
