## DATA TO KNOW AND REMEMBER

1. Globally (excluding the U.S.A. and Canada) the constituents of the United Pentecostal

Church International (UPCI) numbered 4,383,513 in 2019. This is an increase of 209,371 over the previous year.

- 2. Globally, the total number of persons baptized and filled over the last 14 years is as under:
  - Baptized: 1,498,913
     Filled: 2,019,047
- 3. National ministers of the UPCI numbered 30,635 in 2019. This is an increase of 948 over the previous years.
- 4. In 1945, the UPCI had 40 missionaries on foreign fields. In 2015, 70 years later, the UPCI had 869 missionaries on foreign fields.



No one will deny the importance of an experience. Experience is defined as "the process of personally encountering or undergoing something."

By the time the dialogue with Paul ended, these disciples had received the Holy Ghost. Significantly, their experience was the genesis of great spiritual awakening in Ephesus.

## Interesting Times

- $\Rightarrow$  On Pentecost Sunday, 2019, almost every seat in sanctuary of ANAT was occupied by worshippers.
- ⇒ The guest-population numbered at least sixteen (16).
- ⇒ When the service ended, four (4) persons had been baptized in the name of Jesus, four (4) had received the Holy Ghost and one (1) backslider had been restored.
- ⇒ Today, we are celebrating Pentecost Sunday in a virtual manner. The distancing requirements arising out of the COVID-19 pandemic have dictated that worshippers in the sanctuary be limited to ten (10) persons.
- $\Rightarrow$  Consequently, most of our members are participating in today's service via livestream.
- $\Rightarrow$  Sadly, this pandemic has claimed the lives of over 100,000 persons in the U.S.A. Additionally, the infection rate stands at over 1.7 million.

- $\Rightarrow$  Gladly, the pandemic with all its physical, emotional, and mental challenges, has not shut down the operation of the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- $\Rightarrow$  Consider the following:
  - The total number of persons who viewed our Sunday services in April, including Good Friday, was 7,247.
  - With regards to Social Media, the level of engagement with people was greatly increased. For example, for the period April 11 to May 8, ANAT's Facebook page had 9,079 unique accounts, representing a 420% increase over the previous period.
  - Hannah Pommells received the Holy Ghost on Easter Sunday.
  - Yohan Davis received the Holy Ghost last Sunday.
