

Today, we salute all our mothers.

Anna Jarvis is the “mother” of Mother’s Day. On May 10, 1908, she organized the first observance of Mother’s Day to honor her own mother who had died three years earlier.



Interestingly, Katharine Lane Antolini made this statement in her book, **“Memorializing Motherhood: Anna Jarvis and the Struggle for Control of Mother’s Day.”** “It wasn’t to celebrate all mothers. It was to celebrate the best mother you’ve ever known—your mother.” In any event, Mother’s Day became an official holiday in the United States of America in the year 1914, and by the proclamation signed by President Woodrow Wilson on May 9.

In his book, **“All the Women of the Bible”**, Herbert Lockyer made this statement: **“Christian mothers are for the purpose of sending forth into a sinful world those who**

will become the salt of the earth and permeate the world with Christian ideals.”

While many mothers have made positive contributions to the development of their children, none has contributed more than the Christian mother who has fulfilled the purpose stated above. Indeed, such mothers are agents of God in manifesting His greatness. A powerful illustration of this can be found in Jochebed’s action to preserve the life of her baby boy, Moses, and the miraculous events that followed. (Exodus 2, 6:20; Numbers 26:59)

There can be no doubt about it. Mothers do a great work and their worth cannot be fully measured. Many of us can say with Abraham Lincoln, **“I remember my mother’s prayers and they have always followed me. They have clung to me all my life.”**
