Welcome! We are so glad that you have chosen to share with us today's worship experience — whether here at the Tabernacle or via Livestream or another social media platform.

The theme on which we shall focus is, **“JESUS, THE MIGHTY BAPTIZER.”** The Biblical text is Matthew 3:11, **“I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance. But he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire.”**

In this text, John the Baptist conveys a four-point message:

1. He described his ministry: **“I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance,”**
2. He pointed to the fact of Jesus' coming. **“But he that cometh after me...”**
3. He provided his perspective of Jesus. **“He is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear.”**

4. He described Jesus' ministry. **“He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire.”**

The Holy Ghost is not the third person of the trinity. The Holy Ghost is Christ in us the hope of glory. (John 14:16-18; Colossians 1:27) The baptism of the Holy Ghost is essential to full New Testament salvation. (John 3:1-7) And Jesus is the only one who can baptize with the Holy Ghost and with fire.

The term, **“and with fire,”** does not speak to a separate baptism. Rather, it highlights the Holy Ghost in operation. Like fire, the Holy Ghost enlightens, quickens, and purifies the soul. The Holy Ghost inflames the heart with the love of God and with indescribable zeal for the glory of God and the salvation of all mankind.

These challenging times summon us to a deeper realization and utilization of the power within us. O, yes — **“Greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.”** (1 John 4:4)

Scenes of Recent Baptisms
