whom it is directed. We praise the Lord who created the heaven and the earth. He is the only creator. (Genesis 1:1) Consider the content of Psalm 95:3-5)


1. The Lord is a great God.

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL



1. The COVID-19 pandemic experience did not stop this year's Vacation Bible School (VBS). It only made it virtual.
 2. From August 17 - 21, (between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 2:45 p.m.) forty-five (45) students, (and about fifteen (15) adults who stopped by) were inspired by lessons which were built around the theme, **"ROCKY RAILROAD - JESUS' POWER PULLS US THROUGH."**
 3. Each day, the students learned a Bible point, a Bible verse and a Bible story that amplified the theme.
 4. The lessons were reinforced through art, craft, exercises, and a pre-recorded drama performed by a group from
- the Pentecostals of Alexandria, Louisiana.
5. A staff of thirteen (13) persons worked effectively under the leadership of Sister Nathalie Sutherland.
 6. Interestingly, some children from Georgia, Texas, Florida and Jamaica, West Indies, visited the site.
