**T**oday is another special Sunday. As was the case last Sunday, there will be two services. At 9:30 a.m., our seniors, the majority of whom have not been in the Tabernacle since March 15, will participate in a service under the theme, **“GOD AND SENIORS.”**

Following this service, and at 12:00 noon, the second service will begin. Under the theme, **“DOWN WITH FEAR, UP WITH FAITH,”** worshippers will give honor and praise to God, affirming that these challenging times call not for a response of fear, but of faith—an unshakeable faith in God. Such faith always leads to victory.

God does not discard seniors—those whom the Bible describes as **“the aged men and women.”** They belong to God. And He loves them. Indeed, Scripture makes it abundantly clear that God works with and through seniors. Consider the following:

1. **He will be their guide even to death.** (Psalm 48:14)

2. **He will always sustain them.** (Ruth 4:11)
3. **He will make them fruitful in old age.** (Psalm 92:12-14; 37:25)
4. **He will renew their strength.** (Isaiah 40:31)

Significantly, during these challenging times, those who are seniors and those who are not, have a responsibility to respond not with fear, but with faith. This is the right thing to do. And we can do it because of the strength God give us.

Let me repeat for emphasis. Faith in God always leads to victory. To this, Joseph would say, **“AMEN!”** It took a long time, but, eventually, he went from prison to Pharaoh’s palace, and from being a prisoner to being second to Pharaoh in Egypt.

Let the words of our theme be your watchword. **“DOWN WITH FEAR, UP WITH FAITH.”**
