Prayer Program

MATTHEW 9:35-38

35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

37 Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few;

38 Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

This scripture provides us with an invitation from the Lord to partner with Him in expanding His Kingdom. He could expand His kingdom on His own, but He wants us to be active participants in the battle for souls. He wants us to be joint-heirs in this mission. Jesus requested that His disciples pray that the Lord of the harvest would provide needed workers to reap the ripened harvest. They obeyed His desire and became involved in the ministry of preaching, teaching, and healing—they were laborers in His field.



Fasting Plan

There are three choices to participate in this fasting session.

- 1 in 24-hours for 3 days.
- 2 days of complete fast, and 1 day of 1 in 24-hours.
- 3 days of complete fast.

In the same way, we, too, need to fulfill God's desire. The image of a harvest creates a sense of urgency, since crops must be gathered in a timely fashion when they are ripe. When we pray as He commanded, we will see what He sees, feel what He feels, and then do what He did. This will become our lifestyle. We will live with the understanding that the need is urgent and the time to fulfill it is limited.

We are not here on earth simply to exist. We are sent by God with a specific purpose. He did not say that we are to go witnessing; instead, He said that we are to be witnesses. Therefore, witnessing should be an overflow of our love for God that spills out to everyone around us. Witnessing should be the definition of our life, as we represent God's kingdom in all that we say and do.
