JUDE 1

¹ Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to [them that are sanctified] by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called.

² Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied.

³ Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it [was needful] for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should [earnestly contend for] the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

⁴ For there are certain men [crept in unawares,] [who were before of old ordained] to this condemnation, [ungodly men,] turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

⁵ I will therefore [put you in remembrance,] though ye once knew this, [how that] the Lord, having saved the people [out of] the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed [them that believed] not.

⁶ And the angels [which kept] not their [first estate,] but left [their own] habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

⁷ [Even as] Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them [in like manner,] [giving themselves over to fornication,] and going after strange flesh, are [set forth] for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

⁸ Likewise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and [speak evil of] dignities.

⁹ Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not [bring against] him a railing accusation, but said, [The Lord] rebuke thee.

¹⁰ But these [speak evil of] [those things] [which they] know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in [those things] they [corrupt themselves.]

¹¹ Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and [ran greedily after] the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Korah.

¹² These are spots in your [feasts of charity,] when they [feast with] you, feeding themselves [without fear:] clouds they are [without water,] [carried about] of winds; trees [whose fruit withereth,] [without fruit,] twice dead, [plucked up by the roots;]

¹³ Raging waves of the sea, [foaming out] [their own] shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness forever.

¹⁴ And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with [ten thousands] of his saints

¹⁵ To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all [that are ungodly] among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have [ungodly committed,] and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

¹⁶ These are murmurers, complainers, walking after [their own] lusts; and their mouth speaketh [great swelling] words, [having men's persons in admiration] [because of] advantage.

¹⁷ But, beloved, remember ye the words [which were spoken before] of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;

¹⁸ [How that] they told you [there should] be mockers in the last time, who should walk after [their own] ungodly lusts.

¹⁹ These be [they who separate] themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.

²⁰ But ye, beloved, [building up] yourselves on your [most holy] faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

²¹ Keep yourselves in the love of God, [looking for] the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

²² And of some [have compassion,] [making a difference:]

²³ And others save with fear, pulling them [out of] the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

²⁴ Now unto [him that is able] to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless [before the presence] of his glory with [exceeding joy,]

²⁵ To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen.

The church was born on the day of Pentecost. Having started in a blaze of fire it was able to reach the whole world. Indeed, the whole world witnessed it and was attracted to it. Thousands were added to the church through the power and anointing of the Holy Spirit that fell on the disciples. The flame that the church started with continued to spread abroad. The members were all united in one accord, with one aim and one purpose, until pride, unbelief, and evil started to infiltrate the camp. False doctrines, traditions of men, and skepticism all attempted to extinguish this fire. Though the flames diminished, the fire never went out. The embers continued to burn amidst persecutions and trials, and the church remained alive, triumphing over evil. It is our responsibility to continue fanning the embers so that the flame can burn brightly for the world to see and be drawn to our Saviour. Jude encourages us to diligently contend for the faith that was delivered to us, thereby keeping the fire of the Holy Ghost burning in our hearts and directing our lives. Why? The verses below show the awful outcome of the alternative path.

- “For there are certain men [crept in unawares,] [who were before of old ordained] to this condemnation, [ungodly men,] turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.” (Jude 1:4)
- “[Even as] Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them [in like manner,] [giving themselves over to fornication,] and going after strange flesh, are [set forth] for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.” (Jude 1:7)

As we contend for this great church, Paul reminds us that:

- The church is a family, and the goal is maturity. (1 Corinthians 3:1-4)
- The church is a field, and the goal is quantity. (1 Corinthians 3:5-9)
- The church is a temple, and the goal is quality. (1 Corinthians 3:9-23)
