

### Objective

he objectives of this fasting program are consistent with biblical teachings and principles on this important spiritual discipline, as described in Isaiah 58:1-6. The main focus of our fasting will be to deepen our communication with God towards receiving a greater revelation of His character, His Glory, and His manifest presence. It will provide an opportunity to loosen the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free and to break every yoke, as we prepare to be rapture-ready in our walk with Christ Jesus.

### Context

E BELIEVE in the Incarnation, that God became flesh and dwelt among us.

WE BELIEVE in the Crucifixion, that He died on the cross for our sins.

WE BELIEVE in the Resurrection, that Jesus rose victoriously and bodily from the grave.

WE BELIEVE in the Ascension, that Christ ascended back into heaven.

WE BELIEVE in the Exaltation, that Christ is seated at the right hand of God, with all power and authority.

The next event on the prophetic calendar is the Rapture of the Church.

At Jesus' ascension, the angel said: "Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven". (Acts 1:11)

Jesus will return, and His return will be sudden. When discussing His imminent return, Jesus used two Old Testament events to illustrate the certainty and the suddenness of His coming: The Flood (Genesis 6-8) and The Destruction of Sodom (Genesis 19). In both examples, the people of the world were caught unprepared as they engaged in their everyday activities of eating and drinking, marrying, buying, and selling. Jesus will return at any time without warning or notice. The day of His return is a mystery. Only believers will be ready.
